Category Descriptions and Definitions

Bed Quilt – Pieced Traditional – Large:

Intended for use on a bed. Traditional style patterns used. **Size:** Sum of all sides equals 340 inches or more.

Bed Quilt – Pieced Traditional – Small:

Intended for use on a bed. Traditional style patterns used. **Size:** Sum of all sides equals 339 inches or Less.

Bed Quilt – Mixed Techniques – Large:

Intended for use on a bed. Constructed of pieced, applique and other embellishments. **Size:** Sum of all sides equals 340 inches or more.

Bed Quilt – Mixed Techniques – Small:

Intended for use on a bed. Constructed of pieced, applique and other embellishments. **Size:** Sum of all sides equals 339 inches or Less.

Wall Hanging – Pieced Traditional – Large:

Intended for hanging on a wall for display. Pieced with traditional style patterns. **Size:** Sum of all sides equals 151 inches or more.

Wall Hanging – Pieced traditional – Small:

Intended for hanging on a wall for display. Pieced with traditional style patterns. **Size:** Sum of all sides equals 150 inches or less.

Wall Hanging – Mixed Techniques – Large:

Intended for hanging on a wall for display. Constructed of pieced, applique and other embellishments. **Size:** Sum of all sides equals 151 inches or More.

Wall Hanging – Mixed Techniques – Small:

Intended for hanging on a wall for display. Constructed of pieced, applique and other embellishments. **Size:** Sum of all sides equals 150 inches or less.

Lap/Baby Quilt – Pieced Traditional

Intended for use of Baby, Pieced with traditional style patterns. **Size – No Restrictions.**

Lap/Baby Quilt – Mixed Techniques

Intended for use of Baby, Constructed of pieced, applique and other embellishments. **Size: No Restrictions.**

Innovative/Whole Cloth/Art Quilt – Large

Non Traditional pieced (Curved Piecing) and/or Mixed Media such as Embellishments, paints, Angelina hair etc.. are used in the construction of quilt. Made as an expression of art. Size: sum of all sides equals 151 or more. *Note: Whole cloth is constructed on one piece of fabric.*

Innovative/Whole Cloth/Art Quilt – Small

Non Traditional pieced (Curved Piecing) and/or Mixed Media such as embellishments, paints, Angelina hair etc.. Are used in the construction of quilt. Made as an expression of art.. Size: sum of all sides equals 150 or less. *Note: Whole cloth is constructed on one piece of fabric.*

Miniature:

Completely scaled down in all features from a large quilt design.

It may be no larger than 24 inches square or have a perimeter no greater than 149 inches. All techniques are included in this category.

Guild Challenge:

2009 or 2010 Challenge quilts or older if they have not previously been shown in the Cabarrus Quilt show. **You may enter more than 2 quilts in this category only.**

Guild Projects/Group/Team:

Has 3 or more persons working on the construction of the quilt for group/team. Example would be Row x Row or Medallion quilts. Guild projects would be BOM/Mystery quilts etc..

Junior Quilter:

Based on the age of the quilter. ***Must be 18 years old or younger.***

All Techniques are included in this category.

New Quilter:

Based on the time of quilting experience. ***Must be quilting for Two Years or Less.*** All Techniques are included in this category.

Wearable Arts:

Fashionable and wearable garment constructed of 3 layers joined by quilting. Single pieces qualify and ensembles will be considered as a single entry. Examples: Hats, Pocket bags, totes, jackets.

Other:

Anything that does not fit into any other category. Please indicate on your form if this can be hung or would need a table display. Examples: Dolls, Tree Skirts, stockings, pin cushions, felted items, wearable arts that are not 3 layers joined with quilting.
